The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board is a co-management board set up to handle environmental assessments in the Mackenzie Valley.







Responsibilities of the Review Board

- To enable MV residents to participate in the management of its resources for the benefit of MV residents and all Canadians
- To ensure the concerns of aboriginal people and the general public are taken into account
- To protect the bio-physical environment and the social, cultural and economic well being of MV residents and communities
- ...through the conduct of EA and EIR processes





Is it Significant?

We test developments to see if there are:

- 1. Significant adverse environmental impacts, or
- 2. Significant public concern

Tests

Preliminary Screening = "Might" test Environmental Assessment = "Likely" test



Our Job

- 1. Administrator: Run the EA Process
- 2. Educator: Develop Guidelines for how the EIA Process works
- 3. Facilitator: Engage all Interested/Affected Parties into the Process as fully as possible and assist dialogue on development changes
- 4. Decision Maker: Make quality decisions on whether developments should proceed, and under what conditions



What We Heard from you Last Year . . . WORDS into ACTION

SCOPING should focus on unique aspects of each development

CAPACITY is limited particularly in communities

COMMUNICATION & CONSULTATION need improvement

IMPROVE WORKING RELATIONSHIPS to clarify mandate responsibilities and clarify issues upfront in an EA

TRADITIONAL KNOWLEDGE – keeping it in the forefront of EAs


