Re: EA1617-01, Tlicho All-season Road, flight video available on registry

The Review Board received two videos from the GNWT capturing a helicopter flight travelling along the all-season road route. Both videos are of the same flight, but differ in their quality. The first video was compressed for easier distribution. The second video was not.

The Review Board is working to upload the videos to the public registry for public access. Currently the size restrictions and formatting do not allow for this. The Review Board is also working with the GNWT-DOT to make the video available through other means. An update will be distributed when a solution is presented.

Anybody wanting to view a copy of either video while an online solution is being developed is welcome to come by the Review Board office to view it. Following are some notes from the GNWT regarding the videos:

- 1. This fly over video was taken in the fall of 2013, prior to the 2014/2015 forest fires so portions of the environment have since changed.
- 2. There is no audio as this video is displayed in double time to reduce the length of the video. The video is 8:30 min long and stops at the La Martre River.
- 3. As this video is from 2013, it does not show the final TASR alignment that was submitted with our application to the WLWB. The project intends to follow the alignment shown on the video as best as possible; however, certain areas have been realigned for engineering or other relevant purposes. As the video proceeds very quickly over the alignment, it is too difficult to point out exact areas where minor route refinements have been made. The video's purpose is to illustrate this is a disturbed alignment that has been present for many years and is still used today.
