

**RE:** **MVEIRB Information Request, Canadian Zinc Corporation**

1. In response to Request Item 3, I have enclosed a copy of a report prepared for INAC by Public Works and Government Services, the pertinent page of a report (with cover letter) of an inspection by Mr. Wayne Puznicki conducted on 18 August, 1999, and a memorandum to Mr. Dan Elliott from Mr. Daniel Quevillon, regarding a site visit on September 7, 2000. I also enclose copies of a laboratory result of water samples taken on 2 September, 1999, from Sundog Creek, near the fuel cache.
2. In response to Request Item 4, it is DIAND's view that the fuel and the tanks currently situated at Sundog Creek and which Canadian Zinc Corporation is proposing to relocate belong to Canadian Zinc Corporation.
