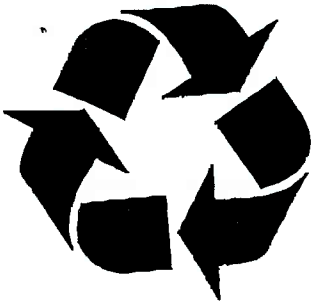

The Akaitcho Territory Government has signed an Interim Measures Agreement in Lutselke June 28, 2001 with the Government of Canada and the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT). The Deninu Kue First Nation is requesting any comment on the proposed Patterson Sawmill Ltd. Development be deferred until September when our Prescreening Board is established.

Canada and the GNWT acknowledged

- ✓ That the Akaitcho Dene First Nation (DFN) asserted their traditional territory in a map attached to the Framework Agreement.
- ✓ The Akaitcho DFN have their own internal processes for determining the use of lands and water.

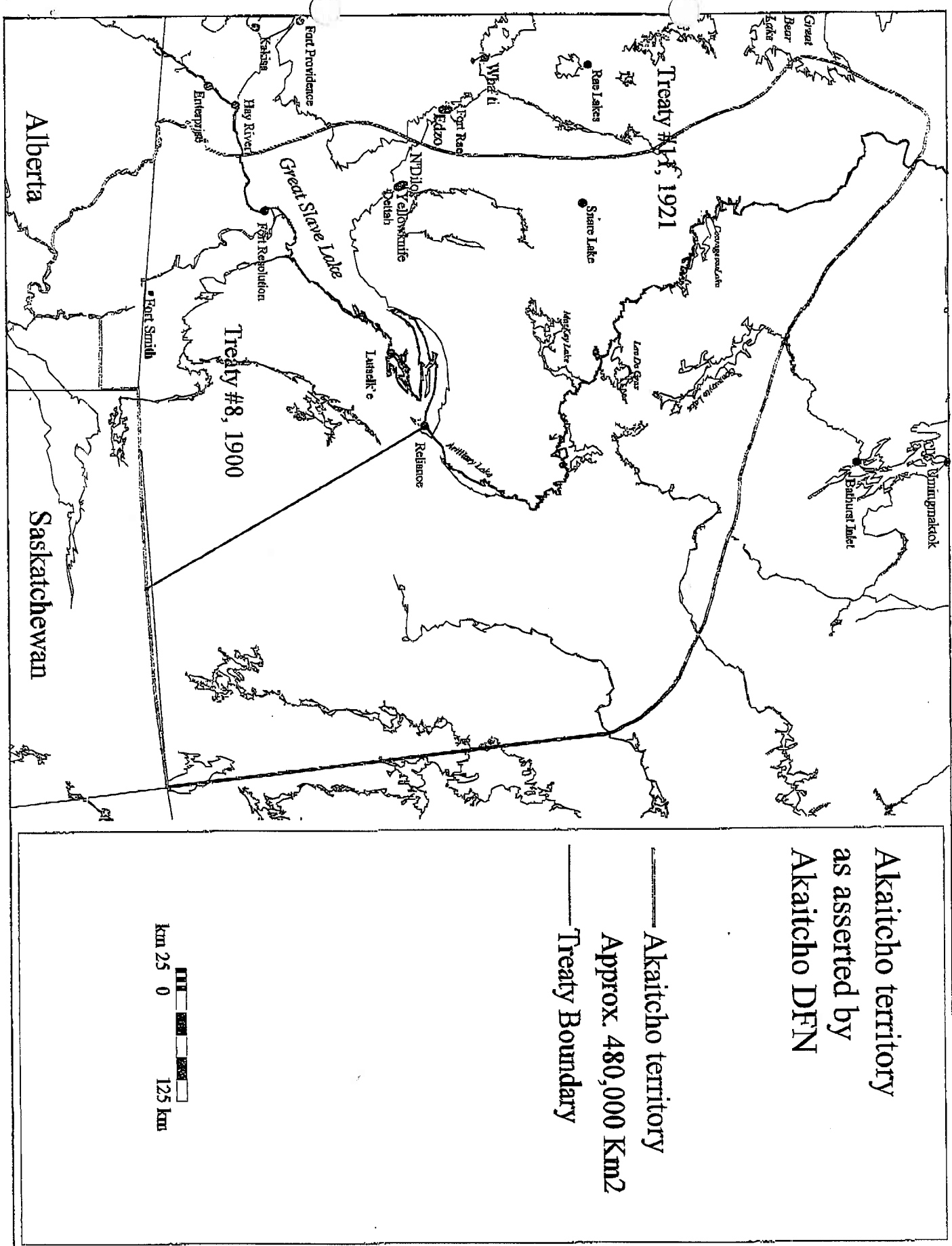
