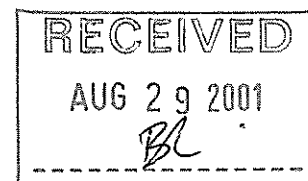

Re: Closure Date of Public Registry for the Prairie Creek Environmental Assessments

Louie,

CPAWS-NWT is requesting that the public registry in this EA remain open until at least Wednesday, September 5, 2001. We request this for two reasons:

- The timing of the site visit to the mine (August 30) does not leave enough time to incorporate results of the visit into our submission before the scheduled close of the public registry (August 31).
- CPAWS-NWT received no substantive information in the August 17, 2001 DIAND response to the two information requests we submitted. We understand that DIAND is currently involved in an internal process in order to answer our requests. It is therefore not possible to at this time to incorporate information from the response into a submission. We request that the public registry remain open for one week after the date substantive responses to the information requests are received.
