## Dear Ms Sian

In addition to Robert Paterson's letter of Oct 17 regarding details of kimberlite "bulk" sampling by Snowfield Development Corp, I would like to illustrate the relatively small scale of such work. Each trench would require the clearing of trees from an area the size of a drill pad or 100 meters square followed by the excavation of a trench similar to that of digging up a small drainage culvert in a roadway.
