Tyhee NWT Corp - Yellowknife Gold Project Distribution List

Re: Notice of Referral to Environmental Assessment – Tyhee NWT Corp – Yellowknife Gold Project

On May 4, 2005, the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (LVLWB) referred Tyhee NWT Corp's land use permit application (MV2005D0009) and water licence application (MV2005L2-0003) for gold mining and milling at the Yellowknife Gold Project properties (the "Development") to Environmental Assessment, pursuant to section 125 of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act. The Development was referred to environment assessment based upon the MVLWB's judgment that the Development might have a significant adverse impact on the environment.

The proposed Development includes:

- Establishment of a 1500 tonne/day underground gold mine with an operating life of 8 years
- Utilization of Winter Lake as a tailings containment area
- Storage of up to 12 million litres of fuel
- Withdrawal of up to 132, 538m³ of fresh water per year from Giauque Lake

The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (the "Review Board") will determine the scope of both the project and the assessment, and will provide a draft Terms of Reference and Work Plan (ToR). In preparation of the draft ToR, the Review Board anticipates, in the near future, holding issues scoping sessions with interested parties to help identify what aspects of the Development require further examination in the environmental assessment. To prepare for the scoping sessions, interested parties are strongly encouraged to begin their review of Tyhee NWT Corp's development description to identify any information gaps. Parties wishing to obtain a complete copy of the Development description are advised to contact the Review Board.
