Re: Information Requests to the Yellowknives Dene First Nation (YKDFN)

Dear Ms. Crapeau,

The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (Review Board) is conducting environmental assessments of Consolidated Gold Win Ventures' (CGV) [EA0506-005] and Sidon International Resources Corp's (Sidon) [EA0506-006] mineral exploration programs. The EA process for those two developments was significantly delayed due to the inability of the Developers to submit Information Requests (IRs) that met Review Board's requirements and expectations. In July 2007, Rescan Environmental Services was engaged to assist the Developers through the environmental assessment process and re-submitted responses were received on November 7th, 2006. The distribution lists for the two EAs have been notified regarding the submissions.

The public concern expressed by the YKDFN during the preliminary screening of the two developments was the principal factor leading the Review Board to conduct environmental assessments on its own motion pursuant to subsection 126(3) of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*. The participation of the YKDFN is essential for the Review Board to understand the nature of public concern surrounding these developments.

The Review Board has not yet received responses to information requests issued to the YKDFN on October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2005. For your reference, those IRs are attached to this correspondence. We would appreciate an indication of when we can expect responses to these IRs in order that we can adjust the Work Plans and complete the EAs for these proposed developments.
