Re: Report of Environmental Assessment and Reasons for Decision on the Tamerlane Ventures Inc. Pine Point Pilot Project (EA0607-002)

The Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada and the other Ministers with jurisdiction related to the above noted project (Responsible Ministers) are currently reviewing the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board's Report of Environmental Assessment and Reasons for Decision on the Tamerlane Ventures Inc. Pine Point Pilot Project, dated February 22, 2008 (Report of Environmental Assessment).

In its Report of Environmental Assessment the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board determined, pursuant to paragraph 128(1)(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act, that an environmental impact review of the proposed development is not required. In its opinion the proposed development, as described in the Report of Environmental Assessment "is not likely to have any significant adverse impacts on the environment or be a cause of significant public concern, provided the commitments made by the developer during the environmental assessment are implemented."

Pursuant to paragraph 130(1)(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act, the Responsible Ministers may agree to order an environmental impact review of the proposed development, notwithstanding the determination of the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board under paragraph 128(1)(a). The Responsible Ministers are presently determining whether to exercise this authority, and in doing so the Responsible Ministers are also considering section 35 of the Constitution Act, 1982.

Subsection 129(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act states that where the Review Board makes a determination under paragraph 128(1)(a), a "regulatory authority...shall not issue a licence, permit or other authorization for the development...before the expiration of ten days after receiving the report of the Review Board."

The Responsible Ministers request that the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board not commence the regulatory process for issuing a land use permit and water licence for the Tamerlane Ventures Inc. Pine Point Pilot Project until the Responsible Ministers have completed their decision process under paragraph 130(1)(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act. The Responsible Ministers endeavour to complete this process by April 14, 2008. By this date, the Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development will, on behalf of the Responsible Ministers, advise the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board and the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board of the Responsible Ministers' decision.
