On September 11, 2006 our office received the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board's referral of your Land Use Permit application (MV2006C0019) for mineral exploration at Screech Lake area East of Great Slave Lake, Northwest Territories to Environmental Assessment, according to section 125(1) of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act.
