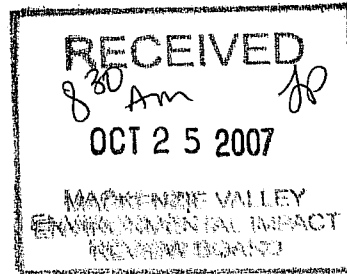

Re: The Four Upper Thelon LUP applications

Dear Mr. MacDonald;

In response to your request for comment on how to proceed with these four applications that are very similar I would like to suggest that evidence and all other materials be drawn from the UR_Energy file. From our organization's perspective the evidence is in fact identical.

1. Evidence transfer – Transfer all evidence from the UR file.
2. Scoping – Again developments are similar enough to transfer relevant information from the UR file.
3. Gathering New Evidence – The use of rounds of Information Requests should be sufficient since very little additional evidence will be presented from the cultural/spiritual/environmental side. A generic terms of reference with room for additional comments will suffice.
4. Public Hearing – We prefer no public hearing as all evidence on cultural and environmental concerns will be the same as the UR-Energy file.
