Notice of Referral to Environmental Assessment - Dezé Energy Corporation, Taltson Hydroelectric Expansion Project

On October 12, 2007 the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (Review Board) received a referral from the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board for an Environmental Assessment of Dezé Energy Corporation's Land Use Permit (MV2007I0033) and Water License Permit (MV2007L4-0029) applications, on the basis that the proposed development might have a significant adverse impact on the environment and might be a cause of public concern.

As per the requirements of MVRMA s.118(1), no license, permit or other authorization for the carrying out of this development will be issued under any federal or territorial law until the completion of the environmental assessment.
