Wildlife

Initial Issues:

- Potential for increased harvester activity;
- Effects on barren ground caribou due to the transmission line; and
- No rare plant survey.

Dezé Commitment:

 Committed to work with the GNWT and other parties to finalize the Environmental Monitoring Program, Human-Wildlife Conflict Management Plan and other relevant management plans.



Employment and Economic Development

Initial Issues:

- Northwest Territories (NWT) businesses and procurement opportunities; and
- Implementation details on Dezé Energy Corporation's NWT Business Policy.

Dezé Commitments:

 Committed to develop a final version of the Business Employment and Training Policy Framework prior to public hearings in January, 2010.



Archaeological Resources

Initial Issue:

Possibility of impacts to archaeological sites due to erosion.

Dezé Response:

 Through discussions with the proponent, increased erosion was determined to be an invalid pathway for effects on archaeological resources.



GNWT CONCLUSIONS

- The majority of GNWT issues with the Taltson Hydroelectric Expansion Project have been addressed.
- There are no outstanding issues related to the protection and management of archaeological sites.
- Wildlife issues will continue to be addressed with the proponent as it develops plans and programs for the regulatory phase.
