To Parties of the Giant Mine Remediation Project Environmental Assessment:

Re: Further extension to deadline for technical reports

On Feb. 3, 2012, the deadline for technical reports was extended to March 16th, 2012, based on delayed developer responses to the second round of information requests and an estimated hearing date of mid-April.

As the attached correspondence states, the developer has recently advised the Review Board that it will not be prepared for the public hearing until mid-May 2012. Accordingly, the deadline for parties' technical reports has now been extended to Monday, April 16th, 2012.

Please make sure your technical reports clearly provide your views regarding *which parts of the project* will affect *which valued components*, and *how*. Please provide supporting references where possible. Parties must include a one-page plain language summary of their report.
