## **Review Board Hearing Directive**

December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012

The purpose of this Hearing Directive is to define tasks and due dates for hearing process steps from the submission of the developer's post-technical report response to the closing of the public record in March 2013. The public hearing in Yellowknife and community hearing in Fort Resolution will provide the opportunity for the public to present concerns directly to the Review Board. The hearing in Yellowknife will focus on technical issues and the community hearing in Fort Resolution will allow for both technical issues and the views of community residents to be presented.

Hearing process steps and due dates are as follows:

- January 8<sup>th</sup> due date for Avalon Technical Report response, updated list of commitments, and a summary of any project description changes to date.
- January 25<sup>th</sup> pre-hearing conference in Yellowknife.
- February 4<sup>th</sup> deadline for parties' hearing presentations.
- February 8<sup>th</sup> due date for developer's hearing presentations.
- **February 18<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>** conduct of public hearings in Yellowknife.
- **February 26**<sup>th</sup> conduct of community hearing in Fort Resolution.
- March 12<sup>th</sup> filing of hearing undertakings by the developer and parties.
- March 19<sup>th</sup> final written submissions from parties.
- March 21<sup>st</sup> final written submission from Avalon Rare Metals Inc.
- March 21<sup>st</sup> closure of public record.
