Re: Referral to Environmental Assessment: Application for Land Use Permit for Highway Right of Way Clearing, KM 1508 to 1478 Proposed Mackenzie Valley Highway

The Department of Transportation (DOT) of the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) submitted an application to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board for the above noted project on February 1, 2013. In its submission, the DOT requested the application and the associated Mackenzie Valley Highway (MVH) Project be referred to environmental assessment under the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act* (MVRMA).

Upon further consideration, the DOT would like to exercise its authority under Section 126 (2) (a) of the MVRMA and refer the application and associated MVH Project to environmental assessment.
