Dominion Diamond is committed to engaging with potentially affected stakeholders on the Jay Project and has undertaken several engagement discussions with Diavik Diamond Mine Inc. (DDMI) following submission of the Developer's Assessment Report (DAR) in November 2014. Dominion Diamond meetings with DDMI have focused on a number of technical questions arising from information presented in the DAR. Technical topics have included Project Description/Engineering, Water Quality modelling, Air Quality and Caribou. This engagement has involved face to face meetings, presentations, and conference calls.

A summary of the meetings between Dominion Diamond and DDMI are described below.

Date: November 21, 2014

Discussion: DDMI provided information to Dominion Diamond outlining their initial questions relating to the DAR. The main topics of discussion were related to the Water Quality modelling.

Date: December 8, 2014

Discussion: Meeting with DDMI, in preparation for the Community and Regulatory engagement workshops that occurred on Dec 9 through Dec 12. Dominion Diamond prepared presentation materials to provide DDMI with an overview of the topics to be discussed at the workshops.

Date: December 15, 2014

Discussion: Dominion Diamond and DDMI discussed questions relating to Project Description/Engineering, Caribou, Air Quality and Water Quality.

Date: January 13, 2015

Discussion: Dominion Diamond and DDMI followed up on earlier questions, relating to Air Quality and Water Quality.

Date: February 4, 2015

Discussion: Dominion Diamond and DDMI followed up on earlier questions relating to Caribou and Water Quality.

Date: March 12, 2015

Discussion: Dominion Diamond and DDMI followed up on earlier questions relating to the Water Quality modelling and Caribou. In addition, responses to IRs of specific interest to DDMI were discussed.

Dominion Diamond recognizes the importance of all Parties' concerns and is committed to meet with and work diligently to provide information and responses in a timely manner throughout the DAR review process.
