Further to our letter of December 5, 2016 in which we provided comments on the risk assessment (RA) conducted by Oboni Riskope, this letter is to confirm the willingness of Canadian Zinc Corporation (CZN) to meet with Oboni, subject to the Board's approval, to answer any questions that Oboni might have and provide additional details relating to our comments.

We propose to include our road engineering consultant, Allnorth, in the meeting. During the meeting, we propose to show video, photographs and drawings of the road, with commentary by Allnorth to describe and explain the approach taken in terms of road design and operations.
