Re: Key lines of questioning for the technical sessions June 13-16, 2016

The next step in the environmental assessment of the Prairie Creek all-season road project is the technical session from Monday June 13 (starting at 1 pm) to Thursday June 16 in Yellowknife. The technical session will be run by the Review Board staff and the Board members will not be present.

The purpose of the technical session is for parties to discuss issues face-to-face to better understand the project and its potential impacts. The discussions should help inform parties' opinions about whether the project is likely to cause significant adverse impacts. Parties' opinions on the impacts from the project are presented during the hearing phase when parties submit technical reports and present their findings to the Review Board at the public hearing.
