Re: Webcasting EIS Analysis sessions

The agenda for the Gahcho Kue Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) Analysis session is now posted on the Review Board website.

As indicated in earlier correspondence, this session will give the developer an opportunity to present the EIS and will give parties the opportunity to ask questions about any important issues not captured in the Terms of Reference or new questions arising from the EIS or conformity response. It will be facilitated by Panel staff. It is not a hearing, and Panel members will not attend.

To help parties participate in an efficient and cost-effective manner, the session will be webcast live. The Panel's experts will not attend in person, but will participate by **listening to the webcast** and **sending any questions via text messages** to Panel staff in the room.

Parties are welcome to organize themselves in a similar manner, having remote participants listen to the webcast, and send text messages to a party representative in the room who can receive and ask their questions. Any parties doing this must have a representative present in person. Panel staff will not be able to raise questions on behalf of parties' remote participants.

The venue (the Champagne Room at 5004 50th Ave., 2nd floor) will have wireless access.
