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ADDITONAL CONDITIONS ANNEXED TO AND FORMING PART OF LAND USE PERMIT NUMBER MV2000A0041

MV2000A0041; Under 26(1)(a): Location and Area

Inspect Locations – The Permittee shall, accompanied by an Inspector, conduct a joint inspection of the selected wellsite(s), remote sump(s), campsite(s) and quarry site(s) prior to any clearing or use of the sites taking place.

ADDITONAL CONDITIONS ANNEXED TO AND FORMING PART OF WATER LICENSE MV2000L1-0009

MV2000L1-0009; Under Part D: Conditions Applying to Waste Disposal

The Permittee shall submit to the Board for approval prior to the start of well test flaring a Flaring Plan that will include but not be limited to:

- a) a post flaring assessment report;
- b) a monitoring program including meteorological monitoring to provide real time confirmation of meteorological conditions during flaring;
- c) explore and report on options considered other then flaring; and
- d) a response plan, estimating H₂S levels encountered during testing.
