#### **REASONS FOR DECISION**

Issued pursuant to Section 26 of the Northwest Territories Waters Act, R.S.C. 1992, c.39

### BACKGROUND AND REGULATORY HISTORY

Canadian Zinc Corporation (the Licensee) applied to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) on March 5, 2001 for a Type 'B' water license, MV2001L2-0003 (the License). The application included underground decline development and metallurgical pilot plant operation among the activities planned for the Prairie Creek minesite, in the Deh Cho Region of the Northwest Territories (NT). The application was referred to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (MVEIRB) for Environmental Assessment (EA) pursuant to section 126(2) of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act (MVRMA). The MVEIRB notified the Licensee on April 14, 2001 that the proposed developments would undergo an EA.

The MVEIRB submitted their Report of Environmental Assessment (EA Report) on February 5, 2002 to the Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (the Minister). On September 3, 2002, the Minister exercised his authority under section 130(1)(b)(i) of the MVRMA and instructed the MVEIRB to give further consideration to unresolved issues in the EA Report relating to the Tailings Containment Area (TCA), and water treatment in general. The MVEIRB released its Reasons for Decision on April 4, 2003, recommending revisions to be made to the recommendations in its February 5, 2002 EA Report. On June 16, 2003, the Minister approved the revised Reasons for Decision document and directed the MVLWB to proceed with the licensing process.

Section 62 of the MVRMA requires that the MVLWB incorporate into a water license, to the extent of its authority, any recommendations approved by the Minister in an EA Report. One of the recommendations approved by the Minister in the Reasons for Decision associated with the EA Report was that:

"CZN is required to file with the MVLWB and the federal Minister, a favourable geotechnical assessment and engineering certification of the suitability of the tailings pond before it can be used. This assessment must certify that the tailings pond liner is intact and impermeable, and that the soil underlying and surrounding the tailings pond is stable."

To satisfy this Ministerial recommendation, the Board issued the Licence on September 10, 2003 with the following condition under part D, item 2:

"The Tailings Containment Area [Tailings Pond] is not to be used in conjunction with the licensed undertakings."

Following the issuance of the Licence which included the condition quoted above, the Nahanni Butte Dene Band, Pehdzeh Ki First Nation and the Dehcho First Nations filed an action seeking judicial review. These parties asserted that the Board had exceeded its jurisdiction by not incorporating the exact wording from the EA Report into part D, item 2.

The judicial review ended on December 20, 2005 with the issuance of an Order with Reasons for Order from the Federal Court of Canada. The Order requires that the Board re-issue the Licence with the following rectification to part D, item 2:

"The Licensee shall submit to the Board for approval a favourable geotechnical assessment and engineering certification of the suitability of the Tailings Containment Area before it can be used in conjunction with the licensed undertakings. This assessment must certify that the tailings pond liner is intact and impermeable, and that the soil underlying and surrounding the Tailings Containment Area is stable."

The Board has now rectified part D, item 2 in accordance with the Court's Order.
