Re: Notice of Referral to Environmental Assessment – CARD-INAC, Giant Mine Remediation

On March 31, 2008 the City of Yellowknife referred the Contaminants and Remediation Directorate (CARD) of the Department of Indian and Northern Affairs' (INAC) application for a Water License (MV2007L8-0031) for the Giant Mine Remediation Project to environmental assessment (EA), according to section 126(2)(c) of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*. The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board received this referral on April 7, 2008 and has begun the EA process.

Until the assessment is concluded no permit or other authorization required for development under territorial or federal law can be issued. The Review Board will create a public registry for this file, where all pertinent information will be held.
