The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (the Review Board) is holding a community hearing in Lutsel K'e on Tuesday, January 16, 2007.

The hearing is about Ur Energy's proposed uranium exploration program at Screech Lake in the Thelon River watershed. The proposed exploration program would include 5 to 20 diamond drill holes.

The Review Board is conducting the environmental assessment of the proposed development. As part of the environmental assessment, the Review Board wants to hear evidence and public comments about Ur Energy's proposed exploration program.
