

Notice of Public Hearing

The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (Review Board) is holding a public hearing in Fort Resolution on October 16, 2007.

The public hearing will discuss Tamerlane Ventures Incorporated's proposed test mine at its R-190 deposit 48 kilometres east of Hay River. The developer is proposing to use underground mining methods to extract a 1,000,000 tonne lead-zinc deposit.

The Review Board is conducting an environmental assessment of this proposed development and would like to hear any evidence from the parties as well as the views of the public about the proposed development's impacts on the environment and on the social, cultural and economic well being of the residents of the Mackenzie Valley.
