Yellowknife, NT. – The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (Review Board) will release its Report of Environmental Assessment and Reasons for Decision for Alex Debogorski's proposed Diamond Exploration Project on January 6th, 2012 after 3:00 pm (Mountain Standard Time).

The Reasons for Decision document sets out the Review Board's findings on the significance of any impacts on the environment and any public concern. The document will outline whether, in the Review Board's opinion, the development should proceed to regulatory process for licensing and permitting.
