

Scoping sessions in Hay River and Fort Resolution for the environmental assessment of Tamerlane Ventures Inc. Pine Point pilot project

The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board is inviting the public to the following scoping sessions:

Tamerlane Ventures Inc. applied to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board on June 1, 2006 for a water license and land-use permit to extract a 1 million-tonne sample of lead/zinc from their R-190 site west of the former Pine Point Mine, and 48 kilometers east of Hay River. Environment Canada referred Tamerlane's development proposal to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board for an environmental assessment on June 28, 2006.

The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Review Board is responsible for conducting environmental assessments in the Mackenzie Valley of the Northwest Territories.

The information collected during the scoping sessions helps the Review Board determine the Terms of Reference for the environmental assessment of Tamerlane's proposed Pine Point pilot project. The scoping sessions will also allow people to learn more about Tamerlane's development proposal.
