Call for Interest – January 2021 Contract Opportunities

The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (Review Board) conducts environmental assessments in the Mackenzie Valley, Northwest Territories. Technical specialists and advisors are sometimes required during the assessment process to provide the Review Board with assistance in assessing potential environmental and socio-economic impacts of projects on the environment and people.

This document is intended to solicit applications from qualified suppliers capable of providing a variety of technical expertise and support. These suppliers will be added to a list of pre-qualified suppliers to be used by the Review Board when seeking technical specialists.

General call for interest – environmental assessments

In particular, expertise may be required for projects related to:

- mining and advanced mineral exploration
- transportation infrastructure such as highways and bridges
- contaminant and waste management
- restoration and reclamation
- forestry
- hydroelectric facilities and transmission lines
- petroleum production and exploration

Areas of expertise may include potential project effects on:

- terrestrial ecology (wildlife and wildlife habitat, birds, vegetation, etc.)
- aquatic ecology (fish, benthos, etc.)
- soils and surficial geology
- hydrology, hydrogeology, water quality and quantity
- air quality
- social, economic, and cultural values
- community well-being

Specific call for interest – Pine Point Mine environmental assessment

Currently, the Review Board is preparing for the environmental assessment of the Pine Point Lead-Zinc Project located at the former Pine Point Mine, east of Hay River, NWT. At this time, the Review Board particularly requires specific expertise related to:

- hydrogeology, groundwater, and hydrology issues
- the ability to describe potential impacts on these environmental components clearly and effectively

Should you wish to be considered for our source list for either the general call for interest or the interest specific to the Pine Point Project, please submit:

1. your resume or your business information
2. a description of the services you can provide
3. a rate sheet for those services

Your submission should not exceed a total of 40 pages. The Review Board may request further details if needed. Your information will remain active on our list for a period of two fiscal years, after which you will be required to resubmit or update your information.
