


Percy Hardisty

The Review Board is saddened to learn of the passing of Mr. Percy Hardisty on Wednesday April 17, 2019.

We extend our condolences to his wife Betty, and his entire family. Mr. Hardisty is remembered for his dedication, tireless work and his voice of advocacy for the Deh Cho region. He always welcomed conversation and he had a great sense of humor.

Percy Hardisty was born in Wrigley and went to school in Fort Simpson and Yellowknife. In the 1970's Mr. Hardisty served in the armed forces and later on worked in the oil industry in Alberta. He returned to Fort Simpson in 1983. He has worked with Parks Canada, the Fort Providence Residential School Society, the Deh Cho Friendship Centre just to name a few. He served two terms as Chief of Wrigley, first in 1985 and then in 2000. He has owned his own business doing seismic slashing.

Percy Hardisty served on the Review Board from November 2003 until August 2004 when he took a leave of absence to serve as a Joint Review Panel Member for the Mackenzie Gas Project. (JRP). After the JRP's final report he returned to the Board in December of 2009. He was reappointed in 2011 for a three-year term that concluded in March 2014.

We have fond memories of Percy whether it was discussion around the table or on the road heading to public hearings.
