On 30 September 2021, the Canada Energy Regulator (**CER**) received an application from Imperial Oil Resources N.W.T. Limited (**Imperial**) for an authorization to construct and operate a waste management facility (**WMF**) pursuant to paragraph 5(1)(b) of the *Canada Oil and Gas Operations Act*. Imperial proposes to construct and operate a WMF that will be used for the long term and secure containment of non-treatable soils and wastes generated by closure and reclamation activities in relation to its Norman Wells Operations.

In accordance with subsection 124(1) of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*, the Commission hereby notifies the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board of receipt of the Application. The Commission of the CER issued a [Hearing Order](#) for the Application on 12 April 2022.
