Notice of Community scoping session in Whati and Technical scoping session Yellowknife

The Review Board is hosting scoping sessions in Whati and Yellowknife for the environmental assessment of the Tlicho All Season Road. The scoping sessions will help identify and prioritize issues affecting the environment and people that might result from the proposed project.

The Review Board's <u>Reasons for Decision</u> outlines its key areas of concern and rationale for referring the project to EA. These key areas of concern or issues are as follows:

- Changes to access new all-season access to the community of Whati
- Impacts on existing social services
- Impacts on caribou

The scoping sessions in Whati and Yellowknife will ask meeting participants whether there are any other issues that the Review Board should consider in this EA. Government regulators for the GNWT, Tlicho and federal governments, Aboriginal organizations and other interested groups are invited to these scoping sessions. The dates for the scoping sessions are:

- August 18 Whati Community scoping session for Tlicho residents
- August 24 <u>Yellowknife Technical scoping session</u> for government regulators and Aboriginal organizations

Meeting agendas and other logistical details for the scoping sessions will follow next week. General meeting notes covering the discussions will be prepared by Review Board staff and



posted to the public registry following the scoping sessions. The meetings will not be transcribed nor comments attributed to parties or participants.
