
Reference is made to the above noted applications. We were quite surprised to discover that the Fort Providence Metis have been omitted from your First Nation distribution list for consultation when this area is our traditional land use area along with the Deh Gah Gotie Dene of Fort Providence.

Although we as Deh Cho Metis were omitted you have included Lorne Napier of the Metis Nation as part of your distribution list for consultation purposes. This is also quite puzzling to us, as the Deh Cho Metis Communities do not support the Metis Nation therefore, as far as we are concerned they do not have any authority, jurisdiction or interest in this area. We as communities can speak for ourselves concerning any activities pertaining to our traditional land use area.
