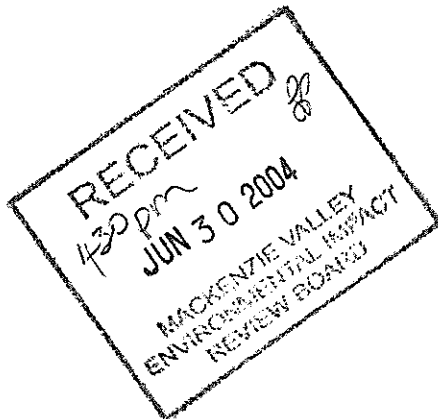

A&R Plan Requirements

This letter is to further clarify what is required by Appendix 1 of Water License MV2001L2-0003 and Land Use Permit MV2001C0023. Appendix 1 requires Canadian Zinc Corporation (CZN) to fully describe how the company plans to undertake complete restoration of **all aspects of the Prairie Creek Mine site that will be affected by or used as part of the appurtenant undertaking**. This includes the infrastructure and facilities that may be required for future proposed activities.

The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB) staff recognize infrastructure at the site may be required in the future; therefore, in addition to the detailed restoration plans outlined above, CZN may provide a list of the infrastructure, either existing or constructed as part of the licensed undertakings, that may be used in future proposed activities.
