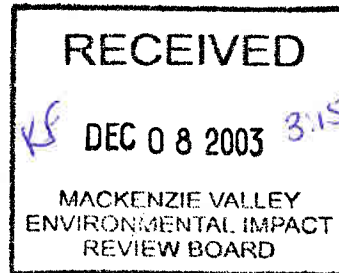



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**ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS ANNEXED TO AND FORMING PART
OF LAND USE PERMIT NUMBER MV2000A0041**

MV2000A0041; Under 26(1)(a): Location and Area

Inspect Locations – The Permittee shall, accompanied by an Inspector, conduct a joint inspection of the selected wellsite(s), remote sump(s), campsite(s) and quarry site(s) prior to any clearing or use of the sites taking place.

**ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS ANNEXED TO AND FORMING PART
OF WATER LICENSE MV2000L1-0009**

MV2000L1-0009; Under Part D: Conditions Applying to Waste Disposal

The Permittee shall submit to the Board for approval prior to the start of well test flaring a Flaring Plan that will include but not be limited to:

- a) a post flaring assessment report;
- b) a monitoring program including meteorological monitoring to provide real time confirmation of meteorological conditions during flaring;
- c) explore and report on options considered other than flaring; and
- d) a response plan, estimating H₂S levels encountered during testing.
