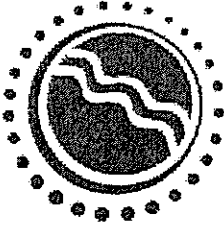

The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board requires more information from Canadian Zinc Ltd. on your proposed exploration development.

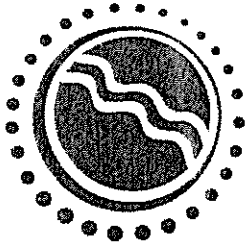
