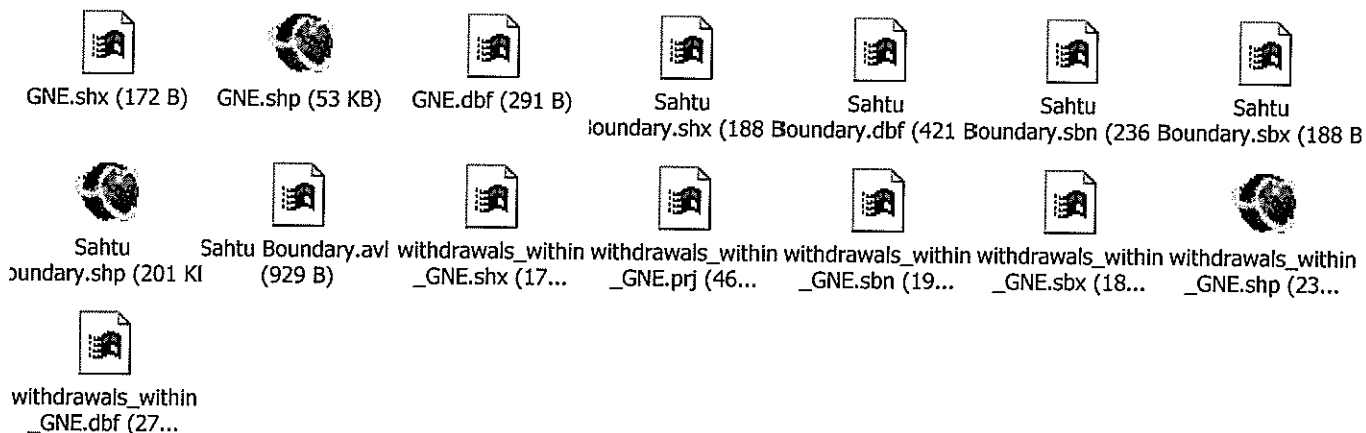

As outlined in the letter sent to the MVEIRB from Kevin McNamee, Director, Park Establishment Branch, the Greater Nahanni Ecosystem is the area of interest for park expansion. Feasibility studies are in progress and this research includes an examination of conservation values and mineral potential. Following consultation with the public, stakeholders and First Nations, the feasibility studies will result in a proposed boundary for an expanded Nahanni National Park Reserve. Through-out the process of expanding Nahanni National Park Reserve, existing third party rights will be respected.
