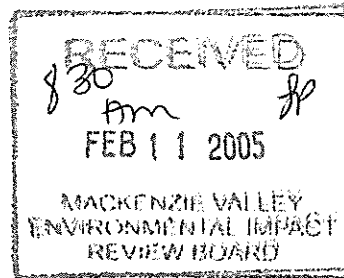

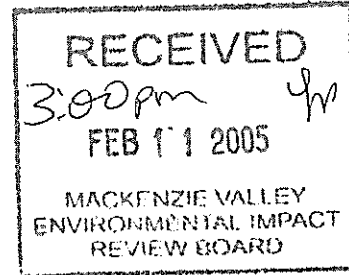


To Martin Haeefe:
