Notes

We made a point of mentioning that Selwyn had not complied with the provisions of chapter 22 of the Sahtu Dene and Metis Comprehensive Land Claim Agreement. This is very important and goes beyond the SocioEconomic concerns mentioned.

Draft Work Plan

The scope of Development must include the cumulative impacts of exploration, development, operation and reclamation of a major Lead Zinc mine in the area.

The community scoping hearings are not "Complete". Accordingly the entire schedule will have to move to track this item.

The "Socio-economic Issues" have to be expanded to look at the provisions of chapter 22 and Selwyn's failure to comply with them.
