

Further to our previous correspondence and our telephone discussions regarding the Talston Hydroelectric Expansion Project, this letter will confirm certain elements of our discussion.

To begin, we confirm that the Carter family does not currently have status in this matter as a party, but that an application for such party status would be considered at the meeting of the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Review Board December 15-17, 2009. Accordingly, please find attached our clients' application for party status. As well, we confirm that our clients, as individuals "pending party status" may attend, along with their counsel, the December 15, 2009 Pre-Hearing Conference.

Further, we confirm that documents and reports may be submitted, and form part of the record of the hearing, at any time prior to the hearing date, and are not required to be submitted by December 11, 2009.


