

## **Review Board to release its Report of Environmental Assessment on proposed Giant Mine Remediation Project**

**Yellowknife, NT.** – The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (Review Board) will release its Report of Environmental Assessment on the proposed Giant Mine Remediation Project on June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at 9:30 am (Mountain Standard Time).

The Report of Environmental Assessment sets out the Review Board’s findings on the significance of any impacts on the environment and any public concern. The document will outline whether, in the Review Board’s opinion, the development should proceed to regulatory processes for licensing and permitting, and will outline any prescribed measures to address impacts.

*About the Review Board*

The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board was established by the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act in 1998 as an independent administrative tribunal responsible for the environmental impact assessment process in the Mackenzie Valley, Northwest Territories. As a co-management board, aboriginal land claim organizations nominate half of the board members, and the federal and territorial governments nominate the other half of the board members. The Minister of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada appoints all of the members to the Review Board.
