Re: Human Health Risk Assessment for Fortune's NICO Project

On April 13th, 2012, Fortune Minerals Limited (Fortune) submitted an update on the aquatic, wildlife and human health risk assessment work completed for the NICO Project. These updates considered the chemistry of the treated effluent that will be produced with a reverse osmosis treatment system rather than the case that was presented in the Developer's Assessment Report using ion exchange (IX).

The attached Human Health Risk Assessment (HHRA) was prepared using the water quality predictions and the associated risk estimates that would be associated with using IX system. Fortune is providing this document so that the methodology and rational of the HHRA is available for review. The conclusions of the HHRA under both water treatment scenarios have not changed.
