

- •Over \$60,000 invested in additional marketing in the past six months to combat growing market realization that aurora viewing could be negatively affected by the Nechalacho project





Effects of the Nechalacho Development Project on Blachford Lake Lodge

- BLL is Avalons closest neighbor 7 km air distance
- •A wilderness resort is not compatible with a mining development
- Concerns fully documented to Avalon and the MVRB a number of years ago

Effects of the Nechalacho Development Project on Blachford Lake Lodge

- •Key issues of economic benefit from the proximity of the site
 - None of our key issues has been mitigated to our satisfaction
 - Ongoing meetings/consultation continue between

 Avalon and BLL
- •BLL in Conjunction with a First Nation joint venture partner (s) will be making a services proposal to Avalon



Future of Blachford Lake Lodge?

- •Future of Blachford Lake Lodge as a wilderness lodge in jeopardy with the emerging Avalon project
- -To continue as a wilderness resort as we have for 33 years on this path is not feasible!
 - •Can BLL offer enough services to Avalon to prove economical?
- Options of a mix of tourism and provision of services or full provision of services?
 - •If the latter, it's a brand new business model
