**Re: Clarification of proposed project & Interim Land Withdraw– August 11, 2010**

On August 9, 2010 staff of the Review Board initiated correspondence with MVLWB to find out information regarding the claims area of the TNR Moose Property recently referred to environmental assessment. The email was to get clarification of the project and the Interim Land Withdraw of the region. The attached simple map of the area indicates that the claims area is not within the ILW, but it does surround it. This information was given by the YKDFN.

### **Background**

On July 23, 2010 the TNR Gold Corp.- Moose Property Exploration application was referred to environmental assessment by the MVLWB. The location of the claims area of the developer is 115 km south east of Yellowknife on the shore of Great Slave Lake. This area is a significant cultural and heritage site and is close to an important travel corridor linking Weledeh, Lutsel K'e and Deninu Kue communities.

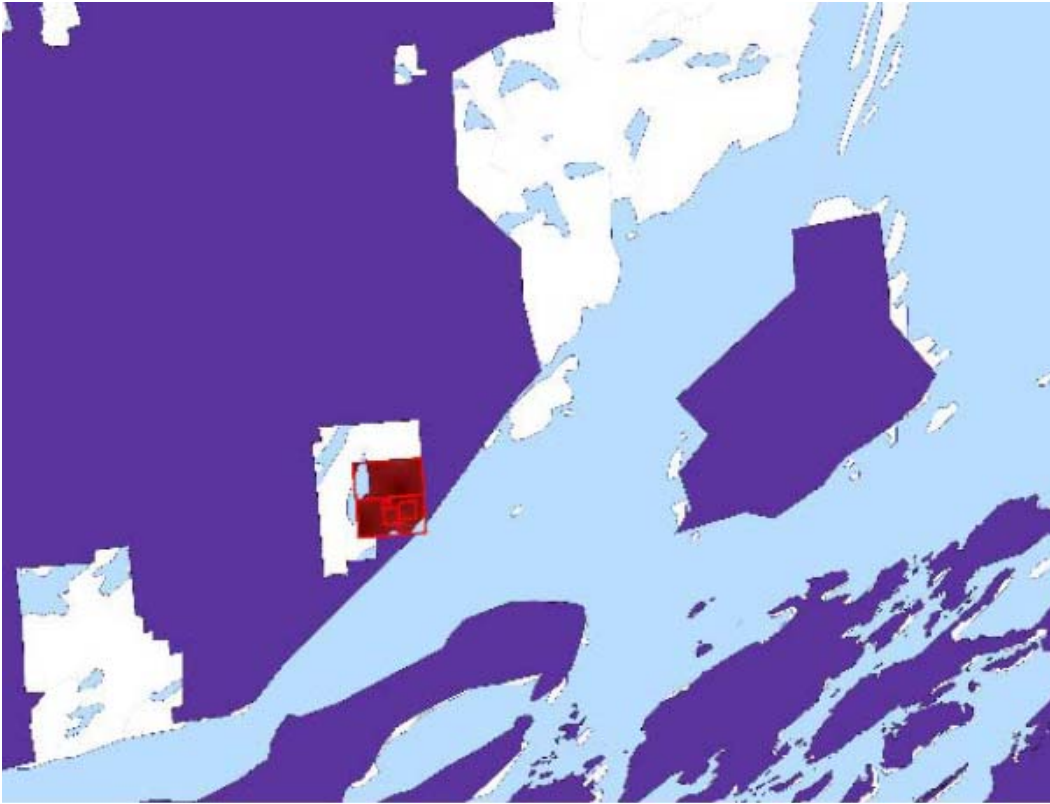
