Dear Mr. Hubert:

As a follow-up to our discussions following the Jay Project Technical Sessions, held April 20 to April 24, 2015 in Yellowknife, NWT, we are pleased to submit a series of documents in relation to conceptual monitoring and management plans for the Jay Project. Specifically, the monitoring and management plans that are provided to support the environmental assessment of the Jay Project, accompanying this letter, include:

- Conceptual Aquatic Effects Monitoring Plan for the Jay Project;
- Conceptual Air Quality and Emissions Monitoring and Management Plan for the Jay Project;
- Conceptual Wildlife Effects Monitoring Plan for the Jay Project;
- Ekati Diamond Mine Wastewater and Processed Kimberlite Management Plan - Conceptual Jay Project Amendment; and,
- Ekati Diamond Mine Waste Rock and Ore Management Plan - Conceptual Jay Project Amendment.

In addition to these plans, we intend to provide a second draft of the Caribou Road Mitigation Plan on or before June 17th for review at a workshop in Yellowknife on June 24th.

Please note that these are initial drafts of the conceptual plans and amendments and are intended for feedback and discussion through the environmental assessment

process for the Jay Project, but would be expected to be finalized during the Water Licence and Land Use permitting process for the Project. These documents are not intended at this point to replace the existing Ekati Mine operational management and monitoring plans which follow a separate review process through the Wek'èezhìi Land and Water Board.

We are committed to continue to work diligently with the MVEIRB and other parties to provide information and responses in a timely manner throughout the remainder of the process.
