Dear Mr. Hubert:

As part of its continuing engagement with potentially affected stakeholders on the Jay Project, Dominion Diamond has undertaken follow-up engagement discussions with the Government of the Northwest Territories, Environment and Natural Resources (GNWT) and their technical consultants following the engagement outlined in our May 25, 2015 letter to the MVEIRB.

Dominion Diamond held a workshop with GNWT staff on July 6<sup>th</sup> to provide further explanation of the water quality modelling that was presented in the DAR, the Technical Sessions, and provided in response to the Round 1 and 2 Information Requests. The MVEIRB technical expert and staff also participated in the workshop.

The purpose of the workshop was to provide additional information regarding the water quality modelling scenarios, linkages, pit hydrodynamic model setup and inputs. MVEIRB and GNWT second round IRs and responses related to water quality modelling were also discussed. Copies of the presentations from the workshop are attached to this correspondence.

A follow-up discussion is scheduled for July 20<sup>th</sup> to address a couple of outstanding hydrogeological modelling questions from the initial workshop.

Dominion Diamond recognizes the importance of all Parties concerns and is committed to work diligently to provide information and responses in a timely manner throughout the DAR review process.
