Re: EA1314-01 Jay Project – Deninu Kue First Nation technical intervention accepted as evidence on the public record

The Deninu Kue First Nation (DKFN) submitted its <u>technical intervention</u> for the Jay Project environmental assessment on July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015, two days after the due date. The DKFN also submitted a letter to the Review Board requesting that this technical intervention be included on the public record.

On August 12, the Review Board asked parties if they had any concerns with including the DKFN technical intervention as evidence on the public record. Parties were requested to respond in writing by August 14.

The Government of the Northwest Territories responded that they have no concerns with including the DKFN technical intervention on the public record for the Jay Project. No other party responded.

The Review Board therefore accepts the DKFN technical intervention as evidence on the public record.
