Prairie Creek All Season Road Project, Canadian Zinc Corporation (CanZinc)

Re: Second round information requests (IRs):

- October 7th deadline for Undertaking #7
- October 7th deadline for IRs and comments related to the September 22nd letter from GNWT Re: Land Tenure Obligations

On September 12, 2016, the Review Board released a <u>note to file</u> regarding an extended deadline of October 7, 2016, for information requests related to undertaking #7. The extension is intended to provide parties sufficient time to review the material submitted by CanZinc on September 6, 2016.

On September 22, 2016, the Government of Northwest Territories (GNWT) submitted a letter to the Review Board related to future land requirements for EA1415-01 project components other than those strictly pertaining to all-season road right-of-way. The GNWT has advised that CanZinc will require leases for barge landings and operation of a barge, as well as for any laydowns, road maintenance facilities, fuel storage, and other facilities located on lots adjacent to the all-season road. To provide parties an opportunity to comment on this new information, information requests and comments from all parties relating directly to topics discussed in this letter will also be accepted by the Review Board until **October 7, 2016**.

The Review Board will set up a **new Review Item** on the <u>Online Review</u> System to address comments and questions **related to undertaking #7 and the GNWT letter**.

The **deadline** to submit information requests **on all other items** or topics remains today – **Friday**, **September 23, 2016.**
