Re: Technical session timing

The Review Board stated in its *Update to Adequacy Requirements for the Developer's Assessment Report*¹ that technical sessions for the Prairie Creek All-season Access Road environmental assessment would be scheduled a minimum of four weeks after outstanding adequacy items were submitted by Canadian Zinc Corporation (CanZinc). Initially, the Review Board proposed a submission date of February 19th, 2016 for these outstanding items and a four-week response period to information requests. Technical sessions would have taken place the third week of March, 2016.

CanZinc emailed² the Review Board on February 12th, 2016 explaining that it expects to submit adequacy items in mid-March. For this reason, the technical sessions will not take place in the third week of March as originally proposed. Canzinc also said that it would provide a new proposed submission date at a later time. The Review Board will not schedule the technical sessions until CanZinc provides further information about submission dates for both the outstanding adequacy items and responses to information requests.
