


WILDLIFE INCLUDING BIRDS AND SPECIES AT RISK

- Special Concern, SARA Schedule 1
- Caribou cross road alignment and spend time close to mine site and road alignment
- Recommend monitoring and adaptive management





- Special Concern, SARA Schedule 1
- CZN committed to presence/not detected surveys
- Recommend baseline survey KP 12 – 39, updated effects assessment, monitoring
- Needed to inform effects assessment, mitigations, and monitoring





- Several SARA schedule 1 species
- CZN has conducted surveys but gaps remain
- Species-specific mitigations may be required
- Recommend baseline surveys, updated effects assessment, monitoring






CLOSURE AND RECLAMATION
