Re: Funding for public participation in the Environmental Impact Review of the Proposed Gahcho Kué Diamond Mine

I am writing to advise you that Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC, formerly Indian and Northern Affairs Canada) is now accepting applications from groups and individuals seeking funding to participate in the environmental impact review of the De Beers Canada Inc's proposed Gahcho Kué Diamond Mine.

I have enclosed a copy of the *Participant Funding Guide and Application Form for the Gahcho Kué Diamond Mine Environmental Impact Review* and a general cover letter outlining the activities that are eligible for funding. Please post these documents on the Panel's public registry website. AANDC is also sending these documents directly to potential applicants. Applicant eligibility requirements are set out in the enclosed guide.

AANDC will be accepting proposals until Monday, July 25, 2011. Following evaluation and recommendations from a Funding Review Committee, we expect that funding allocation decisions will be made by mid-August. Once funding allocation decisions are made, AANDC will work with successful applicants to confirm satisfactory work plans, payment schedules, and other information required to develop contribution agreements. This process may take between several weeks to several months, and only applicants in good financial standing with AANDC will be able to enter into contribution agreements.

AANDC anticipates that the Panel will be issuing a final work plan for the EIR in the near future. Should the Review Panel release the final work plan before July 25, AANDC encourages applicants to consider that document when preparing their applications.
